Children's Music Director

An active, family-oriented church with a growing congregation is looking for an experienced music teacher who is energetic and able to catch a vision for a growing ministry area. This job would entail an anticipated 25-30 weeks of work annually, within the school year. Each week the music instructor would be expected to put in an average of 3 hours, including 2 hours during the scheduled children's programming on Sunday evenings (5 – 7 p.m.), some set-up/break-down and some administrative planning.

Specific details would include the following:

- Coordinate the children's music program, and present for worship 4-5 times during the year (usually October, December, March, April and May).
- Organize and present special music during the Christmas and Easter seasons.
- Be at the church on Sunday evenings (5:00 – 7:30 pm) to work with choirs as a part of the children's programming.
- Have an average of one hour of preparation and organization per week.

An ideal candidate will love working with children, teaching songs and encouraging them in their music-making. Experience presenting small skits would be a plus. Compensation is commensurate with experience.
